



GRAIN POLICY

UNSIGNED / DELINQUENT CONTRACTS

All contracts must be signed within 30 days. After 30 days we will cancel the contract and seek legal damages if necessary. We understand certain uncontrollable issues arise so we are willing to work with you. If delivery is not completed during the contract delivery period, a time extension may be granted. If you do not request a time extension, we will cancel the contract and seek legal damages if the contract is not delivered upon.

DISPOSITION

The scale operator will require accurate information regarding owner's name or names if split, name of the hauler, and the disposition of the grain.

All grain delivered will be applied to an existing contract or will be priced at the closing bid on the day of delivery unless other arrangements are made.

Contract overrun bushels will be priced at the closing bid on the day of delivery unless other arrangements are made.

SETTLEMENTS AND PAYMENT

Upon completion of contracts, checks will be issued within 2 business days following the last load delivered if we have a signed contract on file, unless other arrangements are made.

Deferred payments can be made in any future month if arrangements are made prior to delivery of the last load.

PRICE LATER

Price later contracts will be available depending on space availability. Arrangements must be made prior to delivery. Fees may vary and are subject to change without notice. All pricings will be done using the spot (nearby) bid.
